

DAY-TO-DAY FRENCH LANGUAGE COURSE

The day-to-day French language course is a 15-session semester course.

It takes place on Friday (and sometimes Thursday) * morning from 9:30 am to 1:30 pm.

Who can apply?

You can apply if you live in France and you need to improve your French language skills in daily communication.

You can apply if you have completed the level A1 and above

What are the objectives of this course?

To develop your oral and written communicative skills in order to interact in French in daily life situations, and learn about French culture.

What is the teaching approach?

Our courses are taught by qualified teachers.

Teaching aids are varied, and themes adapted to your level. The teaching methods used in class put you at the heart of your own learning.

Skills assessment

The assessment takes the form of continuous monitoring of the four skills: oral and written comprehension and production.

You can also register for the French language exams organized by the CUEF (DELF - DALF). Please contact the CUEF Reception and student life service for further information

Certificate

A course certificate is issued at the end of the session. It includes your hours of attendance and the level reached at the end of the course in oral and written skills.

Conditions

- A semester-long course
- 60 hours per semester; 4 hours per day* (with holiday breaks for information, go to Prices and Calendar)

*Every Friday (+ 2 Thursdays in September 2025 - 2 Thursdays in April and 1 Thursday in May 2026) from 9:30am to 1:30pm

- From level A1 completed
- Multi-level class

Registration and payment conditions

- Preregister with the CUEF Reception and student life service, in the office or by email: cuef@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr
 - Fees to be paid at the beginning of each semester are:
 - Preregistration fees of 200 euros per semester (non-refundable, deducted from the total cost of the course)
 - Application fees of 30 euros per academic year (non-refundable)
 - Courses fees: semester 1 = 660 euros (from Sept. 11th to Dec. 19th 2025) / semester 2 = 660 euros (from Jan. 9th to May 7th 2026)

NB: Full payment for the course is requested at the start of the course. Any course started is due in full. Days of absence for personal convenience, sickness or holidays will not be refunded.
