### Planning your stay Made up your mind? Simply follow these 4 steps:

1- **Book your course:** fill in the pre-enrolment document available on our website and return it by email along with the booking and administration fees (the remainder must be paid on arrival).

3- **Choose and book your accommodation:** the CUEF offers personalised support and supervision. Host families: between €375 and €1,050 / month\* Student housing: between €310 and €710 / month\* Apartment hotel: between €28 and €80 / night\*

4- **Take the online test:** a test to complete is sent to you a few days before your arrival. You will be placed in a group corresponding to your level from day one of the course.
